# ■ Course Title: English Practicum I

This course is designed to improve students' reading and writing skills while enhancing their English grammar skills, mainly for TOEIC Reading and TOEFL Essay Writing. Students who wish to be recommended for admission to the faculties of Takushoku University must take this course except for those who have a certain level of English proficiency.

\*TOEIC: Test of English for International Communication

\*TOEFL: Test of English as a Foreign Language

# ■ Course Title: English Practicum II

This course is designed to improve students' listening and speaking skills while increasing their speed in using English, mainly for TOEIC Listening and TOEFL Speaking. Students who wish to be recommended for admission to the faculties of Takushoku University must take this course except for those who have a certain level of English proficiency.

\*TOEIC: Test of English for International Communication

\*TOEFL: Test of English as a Foreign Language

### ■ Course Title: Elementary English

This course is designed to prepare students for the level of English required for credits in undergraduate English courses. Students who are assigned to this course by the placement test must take it.

### ■ Course Title: General Subject I

This course is designed to prepare students for the Examination by EJU "Civics" (mainly Politics and Economics).

### ■ Course Title: General Subject II

This course is designed to prepare students for the Examination by EJU "Geography" (Japanese/World Geography) and History (Japanese / World History).

This course is designed to prepare students for the Examination by EJU "Mathematics Course 1" (for liberal arts faculties and science faculties that require relatively less mathematics).

This course is designed to prepare students for the Examination by EJU "Mathematics Course 2" (for faculties that require a high level of mathematics).
