

## 【成績評価】

- (1) 成績は、原則として**素点（0～100）**で発表されます。  
ただし、次のような表示で発表される場合もあります。  
[—]印： **未 受 験**（試験等を未受験の場合）  
[XXX]印： **評価に値せず**（出席不良等で評価に値しない場合）
- (2) 成績の評価は、S・A・B・C・Fで表記します。評価基準は次のとおりです。

- (3) 通年科目は、前期に成績発表を行わず、後期に通年評価としての点数を発表します。
- (4) 不合格科目欄に記載された科目は、原則として、次年度以降再履修し、単位修得すると抹消されます（科目担当教員が異なっても構いません）。
- (5) 学科専門科目「教職」分野の各科目、教職課程科目（教科及び教科の指導法に関する科目のうち教科の指導法に関する科目、教育の基礎的理解に関する科目等、大学が独自に設定する科目）、社会教育主事講座科目、日本語教員養成基礎講座科目については、不合格になっても評価に[F]は付きません。また次年度以降も、学業成績表の不合格科目欄に記載されません。

## 【GPA制度】

GPA (Grade Point Average) とは、科目毎の成績素点に対してGP (Grade Point) を設定し、その科目の単位数を加味して1単位あたりのGPの平均値を表したもので、学修状況を総合的に示す指標です。GPAは次のとおり算出します。

### (1) 各科目のGPを求める

$$GP = (\text{成績素点} - 55) \div 10$$

ただしGPが ① 0.5 未満のときは、GP = 0.0 (59 点以下)

② 0.5～0.9 のときは、GP = 1.0 (60 点～64 点)

③ 4.1～4.5 のときは、GP = 4.0 (96 点～100 点) になります。

### (2) GPAを求める

$$GPA = \frac{(\text{履修登録科目のGP} \times \text{その科目の単位数}) \text{の総和}}{\text{履修登録科目の総単位数 (不合格科目含む)}}$$

#### ①GPAの対象とならない科目

- ・学科専門科目「教職」分野の各科目、教職課程科目（教科及び教科の指導法に関する科目のうち教科の指導法に関する科目、教育の基礎的理解に関する科目等、大学が独自に設定する科目）、社会教育主事講座科目、日本語教員養成基礎講座科目
- ・履修登録の取り消しが認められた科目
- ・素点を示さず、単位認定された科目

②GPAの値は、小数第3位を切り捨てて、少数第2位まで表示します。

### (3) GPAの発表

GPAは、学業成績表に学期（前期・後期）・年度・累積の3種類を記載します。また、成績証明書に累積のGPAを記載します。

## 【GRADE EVALUATION】

(1) As a rule, grades are announced on a scale of 0 to 100.

However, it may also appear as follows

[---] : If you have not taken any examinations, etc.

[XXX] : Not worthy of evaluation (In case of poor attendance, etc., not worthy of evaluation)

(2) Grades will be indicated as S, A, B, C, and F. The grading criteria are as follows.

\*Failed courses will be listed in the "Failed Courses" column of the Academic Record from the following year onward.

(3) For full-year courses, grades will not be announced in the first semester, but scores for the full-year evaluation will be announced in the second semester.

(4) As a general rule, courses listed in the "Failed Courses" column will be deleted when the student retakes the course and earns credits from the next year onward (even if the instructor of the course is different).

(5) For all subjects in the field of "Teaching" in the departmental specialties, teaching course subjects (subjects related to subject teaching methods among subjects related to subjects and subject teaching methods, subjects related to basic understanding of education, and other subjects set independently by the university), subjects in the social education administer course and in the basic Japanese teacher training course, even if the student fails the course, the [ F ] will not be given. In addition, the failing courses will not be listed in the "Failed Courses" column of the academic record for the following year and thereafter.

## 【GPA System】

The Grade Point Average (GPA) is the average of the GP per credit, with a Grade Point (GP) assigned to the grades of the courses taken. It is also an indicator of overall academic progress. GPA is calculated as follows.

(1) Find the GP for each subject

$$GP = (\text{Score} - 55) / 10$$

However, if the GP is ① less than 0.5, GP = 0.0 (59 points or less)

② 0.5 to 0.9, GP = 1.0 (60 to 64 points)

③ 4.1 to 4.5, GP = 4.0 (96 to 100 points).

(2) Seek GPA

$$GPA = \frac{(\text{Sum of (GP of registered courses} \times \text{number of credits for that course)})}{\text{Total number of credits for registered courses (including failed courses)}}$$

① Courses not subject to GPA

- Subjects in the field of "Teaching" in the department's specialized courses, subjects in teaching courses (subjects related to subject teaching methods among subjects related to subjects and subject teaching methods, subjects related to basic understanding of education, and other subjects set independently by the university), subjects in the course for social education administrators, and subjects in the basic courses for Japanese language teacher training.
- Courses for which course registration has been approved for cancellation
- Courses for which no bare scores were indicated and credit was granted

② GPA values are rounded down to the second decimal place.

(3) Announcement of GPA

Three types of GPAs will be listed on the academic transcript: semester (first and second semester), year, and cumulative. In addition, the cumulative GPA will be listed on the transcript.
